After a tumultuous 2020, I'm sure many of you shared my hope that 2021 would bring health and peace to our world. Unfortunately, that was not the case. But like so many other organizations, amidst the chaos, Anchor Center's grace and grit, and its commitment to children, families, collaboration, and quality were never more evident! I remain so proud of our team and the things we accomplished, despite another challenging year.

We completed construction and unveiled our new state-of-the-art eye clinic in the lower level of the Anchor building in October. Dr. Robert King, our Pediatric Ophthalmologist, saw his first patients in the new clinic in November. The new clinic provides ample space for Teachers of Students with Visual Impairments to observe and assist with appointments, for family members to comfortably attend appointments in the exam rooms, and for Dr. King and Dr. Anna Steele to see more patients overall. Families are welcomed to the clinic by a whimsical ocean-themed sensory wall, designed by Maria Cole, original architect of the Anchor Center building. This wall consists of many different elements, textures, and lights, which children can tactilely explore while they wait for their appointment. It has been a big hit!

I want to acknowledge that none of our accomplishments you will read about in this year's Annual Report would have been possible without the support of our steadfast and generous donors. It has been a scary time for nonprofits, as many foundations and donors turned their efforts toward immediate needs, such as food insecurity, mental health, and natural disaster relief. Rightfully so. But a great many of you continued your support, or stepped up for the first time to support us, and that allowed us not only to continue our high-quality services for children and families, but to enhance them. Over the 2020-21 school year, Anchor Center served **110 children**, **248 primary caregivers**, and **22 siblings** through center-based, home visitation, and enhanced virtual services.

## INFANTS (0 - 18 months)

Teachers and therapists help caregivers gain understanding of their child's unique vision challenges and strengths; strategies to care for their infant's special needs; and tools to nurture their child's early development.

“Tivoli, 14 months old, has been in our Infant Program since she was 4 months old. She has a retinal disorder that impacts her vision. It has been so fun to watch her learn and grow over the past year! ## TODDLERS (18 months - 3 years)

Teachers and caregivers work with toddlers on their visual, auditory, and motor development, orientation and mobility, including cane travel and pre-literacy, communication, and social skills.

## PRESCHOOLERS (3-5 years)

Preschoolers receive individualized early childhood special education via the nationally accredited Expanded Core Curriculum (ECC). Preschool advances instruction in orientation and mobility, literacy and braille, prosocial and daily living skills, and the use of assistive technology. Preschoolers also enjoy multisensory education through music and horticultural therapies, as well as community field trips and events.

“ I met Milad in our Infant/Toddler Program almost 2 years ago, and now have the pleasure of having him in my preschool classroom, The Green Squares! A couple of years ago, Milad had trouble processing a lot of clutter; auditory, visual, and physical. Often, he would retreat, avoid, and become upset. The strides he has taken since then are incredible to witness. Coming to preschool, and his family working diligently together has helped Milad integrate his senses and really blossom. ## HOME VISITS (0-3 years)

Provided in the child's home, our Teachers of Students with Visual Impairments (TSVIs) offer one-to-one vision consultation and training to parents/caregivers and children. Our TSVIs assist parents in adapting their homes and practicing techniques to promote and nurture infant and early childhood development, exploration and learning.

“ Harper participates in our Home Visit program and is an exceptional learner. Born with bilateral microphthalmia (underdeveloped eyes), Harper has very limited vision and will be a braille reader in the near future. She already seeks the braille dots in her home environment and in the books we share and read together. The vision she does have she uses intently to examine objects, people, and the environment she navigates. She is drawn to light, patterns, and things with beautiful colors. She creates elaborate rhythms with her feet by the way she methodically hits the floor or the ottoman that sits in the center of her living room. Most of all she is daring and trusting of those she works with and will try anything new and adventurous, as she has so demonstrated at her neighborhood swimming pool by laying back in the water when prompted for learning to perform a back float.

# CORTICAL VISUAL IMPAIRMENT (CVI) DIAGNOSIS BY ENROLLMENT

Roughly 45-50% of our students have been diagnosed with CVI, which is a brain-based visual impairment. That means the eyes are healthy, but the brain is not able to interpret visual information. It is the current leading cause of visual impairment in children in the developing world, including the United States and it often presents with other neurological disorders.
