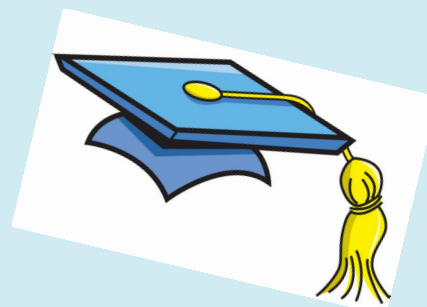
Infant/Toddler News
