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Activity: Alphabet Soup

Now that it is getting warmer outside it is time for some water play!

You will need a large bin or pot, colorful magnetic letters, and a big spoon.

First, Fill the bin halfway with water. After filling the bin with water toss in the magnets. Then let your child explore the bin of magnets and water. After your child gets used to the water and the magnets, see if they can pick up a letter with the spoon. If you child is interested you could ask them to spoon out all the blue letters, or if they know some letters ask them to spoon out the magnets by letter name.

This activity is good for working on those hand eye coordination skills, as well as color identification and letter recognition.
